
# Grade 4 Sovereign Hill Camp 2017

## **Drop off and pick up**

#### Day 1: Monday

- 8:15 am Parents are required to drop off students and bags at **school**. Children keep a small backpack with snack, lunch and refillable drink bottle.
- Drive by bus to Sovereign Hill eat snack (from home) and settle into cabins.
- Eat lunch (from home) and participate in activities at Sovereign Hill.

## Day 3: Wednesday

- Participate in activities at Sovereign Hill.

## <u>Allergies</u>

Please note that we do have children with severe allergies to nuts coming on camp. It is critically important that there are <u>NO NUTS</u> brought to camp, <u>or any food or Iollies with nuts</u>. We understand children will have a small amount of Iollies to nibble on, but all children need to remember not to share their food in case of allergies.

## Medication

 Jacqui Greig on the morning of departure. It needs to be in a clearly named zip lock bag along with clear appropriate instructions. Please ensure all medication is not out of date.

## Epipen -Ventolin -

Please give your child's Epipen to Jacqui!!!

All children must bring a Ventolin from home and carry it with them during all activities. Don't forget your spacer.

Antihistamine - Please remember to send your child's antihistamine in case of any allergic reactions.
